The National Gallery is one of the greatest art galleries in the world. Founded by Parliament in 1824, it houses the nation's collection of paintings dating from the late 13th to the early 20th century.

Stoke-on-Trent City Council is the first partner in the National Gallery's new national touring project *The National* Gallery: Art on Your Doorstep. 15 fullsized printed masterpieces are installed in an outdoor exhibition in Bethesda Gardens, opposite The Potteries Museum & Art Gallery, bringing people and paintings together as part of the city's centenary celebrations.




