
About The Big Feas	The <b>Big Feast</b> is a <b>free</b> festival that happens in <b>Stoke-on-Trent city centre (Hanley)</b> .
<u>A ( B</u>	A <b>festival</b> is an organised set of <b>special events</b> .
	The Big Feast is an outdoor event where art and artists appear in streets and buildings around Stoke-on-Trent city centre (Hanley) for people to enjoy.
O-O-O-ANNUAL	The Big Feast is an annual event. This means it takes place every year on the third weekend of August.
22 23	This year the Big Feast is happening on <b>Friday 22</b> and <b>Saturday 23</b> of August.





Events **start** at **11am** and **end** at **5pm** each day.





The Big Feast events happen in lots of **different places** around the City Centre.

### Finding Your Way Around The Big Feast






During the **festival** you can ask for **help**.



Look for the people wearing this **Appetite logo** or Appetite t-shirts. These are **Appetite Stewards** and are there to help.



The Big Feast events take place in a number of different places.

Each **area** has a different **number**.



**Area 1** – Potteries Centre.

Some events will be happening at various places inside the Potteries Centre. Some performances will also finish outside the Potteries Centre.



**Area 2** – Fountain Square

Fountain Square, near Lloyds bank and Specsavers



**Area 3 –** Tontine Square

Near to Butters John Bee and Halifax.



### Area 4 – Parliament Square

Near to Weatherspoons and McDonald's.





## Area 5 – Crown Bank

Near HSBC Hanley and Little Dessert Shop.

The **First Aid tent** will be in this area.

This is the area for **lost** children and **lost** people.

Please come here if you have lost someone or are looking for someone.



# Area 6 – Piccadilly Stage

Performances will take place on a raised stage at Piccadilly/Cheapside. There will be benches here for you to sit on.



**Area 7** – Lower Piccadilly

Near the Regent Theatre. Some performances will start at lower Piccadilly and then **move** up and down Piccadilly.

Other performances will move and **finish** near Lower Piccadilly.



**Area 8** – Albion Square

This is an outdoor space near B&M.

There will be benches here for you to sit on.



Area 9 – Town Hall

Outside the old town hall.

There will be **benches** here for you to **sit on**.



**Area 10** – Upper Lichfield Street

This is an outdoor area near the Albion Pub.

Performances that start here will then move to a new area and you can follow the performance.



**Area 11** – City Centre Bus Station

We will have performances outside the bus station.

There will be benches here for you to sit on.



**Area 12 –** Bethesda Chapel

Inside Bethesda
Chapel you will find
A Restorative a
relaxing and
dreamlike
experience.



**Area 13 –** Potteries Museum & Art Gallery

There will be some events **inside** the museum, like **See Saw** in the **Old Spitfire Gallery**.

Some events will be outside the museum on the ramp by the entrance. Other outside events will be by the New Spitfire Gallery.

There will be benches here for you to sit on.



Area 14 - Smithfield

At Smithfield, near the new Hanley Library and the Smithfield building which is the big colourful building behind the Potteries Museum & Art Gallery. The Volo VR Swings will be set up outside. As well as a variety of

outdoor performances.

#### Access at the Big Feast



There is an **Access Team** at the Big Feast.

They can **help** you and answer any questions.

They will be wearing green tshirts with the Appetite logo.



The **Access Team** will be around at the **events**.

They may come up to you and ask if you need any **help**.

You can **always ask** one of our access team if you need **help** with something.





The Access Team will be at each BSL and AD show. You can ask them for help, if you need to.



Performances at the Big Feast are **relaxed**.

You can:

- Wear headphones
- Make noise and clap
- Come and go
- Move around



The festival is **busy** and may be **noisy** at times.



Quieter areas of the festival can be found at Area 1
Potteries centre lower mall (lamb street), Area 13
Potteries Museum and Art Gallery, Area 14 near
Smithfield in the Library.



Noise cancelling headphones are available to borrow at the Big Feast just ask one of our Access Team.

museum and art gallery.




All performances are wheelchair accessible. Viewing areas will be reserved for wheelchair users when we are expecting large numbers.



Some performances will be audio described, you can collect headsets for these from our access stewards and at the performance.

The Big Feast **programme** will tell you which performances have audio description, or you can ask





Some performance will have **BSL interpretation**.

The Big Feast **programme** will tell you which performances will be signed.



There will be a **bookable touch tour** for the Ancient Giants performance.

A **touch tour** allows you to touch and feel the puppets and costumes before a performance so you can better understand what they look like.



Touch tours are helpful to people who find it hard to see.
